

## VIEW YOUR SECURITY CAMERAS IN MAC.


Follow these steps if you want to view your Security Cameras from the browser in Mac.

## **RED TECHNOLOGY**


- 1. Enter to your browser. It will only work on: Safari, Firefox or Internet Explorer.
- 2. In address bar type your IP address and HTTP port information and hit enter.
- 3. Put the Username and Password given by your tech team.



Click in trust.




- Click in configuration, and click in Local Configuration.
- Change Auto Start Live view to Yes.




## **BLUE TECHNOLOGY**


• Put the Username and Password given by your tech team.




- If the "No Plug-in detected" text appears, you'll need to install it. This only appears the first time.
- The Plug-in will be given by your tech team or you can follow this link:


• Double click to unzip the plugin.




• Double click in the .pkg file.




• Click continue. Continue Again. Install.




- And your done installing the plug-in.
